

ISCA and ISCA FOUNDATION DISASTER ASSISTANCE FUND

REQUIREMENTS FOR FUNDING

Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be a member of ISCA
2. The applicant must have suffered losses incurred as a direct result of a federal disaster
3. The applicant must live in a federally declared disaster area
4. The applicant must signify the purpose of the funds (i.e.: food, shelter, veterinary bills and so on)
5. Requests for assistance should be directed to Mr. Zirkle via the ISCA website or by mail (address to follow)

Requirements:

1. The ISCA member's name and address (where the disaster occurred)
2. County or parish where disaster occurred (For eligibility verification)
3. The call names of ISCA member's Irish Setters affected by the disaster
4. Description of the financial needs for the Irish Setters in #3 above (veterinary, medications, shelter, care, supplies, transportation, dog food, etc.)
5. Copies of bills or invoices to support the assistance request amount
6. Current address (where to send the money)
7. More than one request can be made if additional assistance becomes necessary later
8. Sign your paper and mail or scan to Jay Zirkle – information below
