_____ **Individual To Family Membership. Additional \$15.** To add one Adult or Junior living in the same household to an existing Individual Membership to make it a Basic two person Family Membership.

_____ **Basic Family Membership. \$70.** Open to any two adults (related or unrelated) living in the same household. Any minor children (aged 9 through 17) of either that are living with them may be listed as non-members. The adults named on the application are able to vote and hold office as an officer, director or delegate. The household will receive one copy of "Memo To Members".

_____ **Senior 1 Membership. \$35.** ONE Adult who is at least 62 years of age. Membership includes voting rights, rights to hold office, and the "Memo To Members".

_____ **Senior 2 Membership. \$35.** TWO Adults living in the same household who are both at least 62 years of age. Membership includes voting rights, rights to hold office, and the "Memo To Members".

_____ **Sr. 1 To Sr. 2 Membership. No Additional Charge.** To add one Adult aged 62 or better living in the same household to an existing Senior 1 Membership to make it a Senior 2 Membership.

_____ **Adjunct Name listing. \$15.** A THIRD ADULT NAME may be added to either a Family Membership or a Senior Membership for an additional charge. **Check the correct box.** The person must be living in the same household. An Adjunct Adult aged 18 or older has voting rights, rights to hold office, but will NOT receive a separate copy of the "Memo To Members". (One copy to the address.)

_____ **Junior Membership. \$30.** Open to persons aged 9 through 17. Junior members may compete for annual awards, but may not vote or hold office in the club. A subscription to "Memo To Members" is included.

PRINCIPLES OF INTEGRITY

Revised April 13, 2013

Members of the Irish Setter Club of America, Inc., agree to abide by the Constitutional objectives of the Club. Among these are provisions to protect and advance the interests of the breed, and to do all that is possible to bring the natural qualities of the Irish Setter to perfection. To further these objectives all members agree to follow these principles of integrity:

1. Comply with all American Kennel Club rules and regulations.
2. Maintain a high standard of health, care and cleanliness for our dogs and dogs entrusted to our care.
3. Act in a sportsmanlike manner and not deliberately degrade other exhibitors/breeders or their dogs.
4. Make every effort to learn about the structure, anatomy, action, behavior and other inheritable traits of the Irish Setter. To use this information to adhere to the breed standard and produce sound, healthy dogs with good temperament.
5. To use or give service only to registered stock that is believed to be free of serious abnormalities which are considered inheritable.
6. To provide a written contract/agreement, signed by both parties, for each sale or service which includes all special conditions related to the sale or service at the time of the transaction.
7. Provide each buyer with accurate written records regarding health and pedigree for the Irish Setter being purchased, leased, or used at stud at the time of the transaction, or when services are provided.
8. Truthfully and realistically represent the Irish Setter being sold in terms of quality, health and genetic history.
9. Refuse to sell to commercial wholesalers, retailers or to research laboratories.
10. When selling an Irish Setter known to manifest hereditary defects considered to be detrimental to the breed, use written contracts or spay/neuter agreements to prevent the dog from being bred.
11. Must agree that if any Irish Setter, on whose papers you are shown as the breeder or co-breeder, should become a part of any breed rescue program, that upon written notification, you will assume financial responsibility for those expenses and assist the Rescue Chair in placing in a suitable home, or assume custody of said Irish Setter.

According to the ISCA Bylaws, failure to adhere to these Principles of Integrity may result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to, suspension of membership and/or other privileges.

MEMBERSHIP 'TERM

- ISCA's Membership Year is January 1 through December 31 of each calendar year.

NEW MEMBERSHIPS

- New memberships or Adjunct Names approved **prior to October 1** of any year will have a shortened first year, expiring December 31st of that year. They will be required to renew their memberships and adjunct status for the following year.
- New memberships or Adjunct Names approved **on or after October 1** of any year will have their memberships and adjunct status extended to include the following calendar year for no additional cost.

MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS

- The annual membership renewal forms are mailed to all members at the end of October of each year, with a request that they be returned as early as possible. To be valid, the returned membership renewal letters must be **postmarked on or before January 31st.**
