The campground has reserved 20 spots for ISCA, both 50 and 30 amp. The reservations may start on Monday, May 29, 2023. They cannot start earlier because of a horse show that is taking up most of the campground. The block will go through Sunday, June 4, 2023 with a mandatory check out at 12:00.

The reservation must include a stay on Friday, June 2 and Saturday, June 3, 2023 due to their rules.

Reservations will open after the 4th of July weekend due to the craziness and high holiday volume.

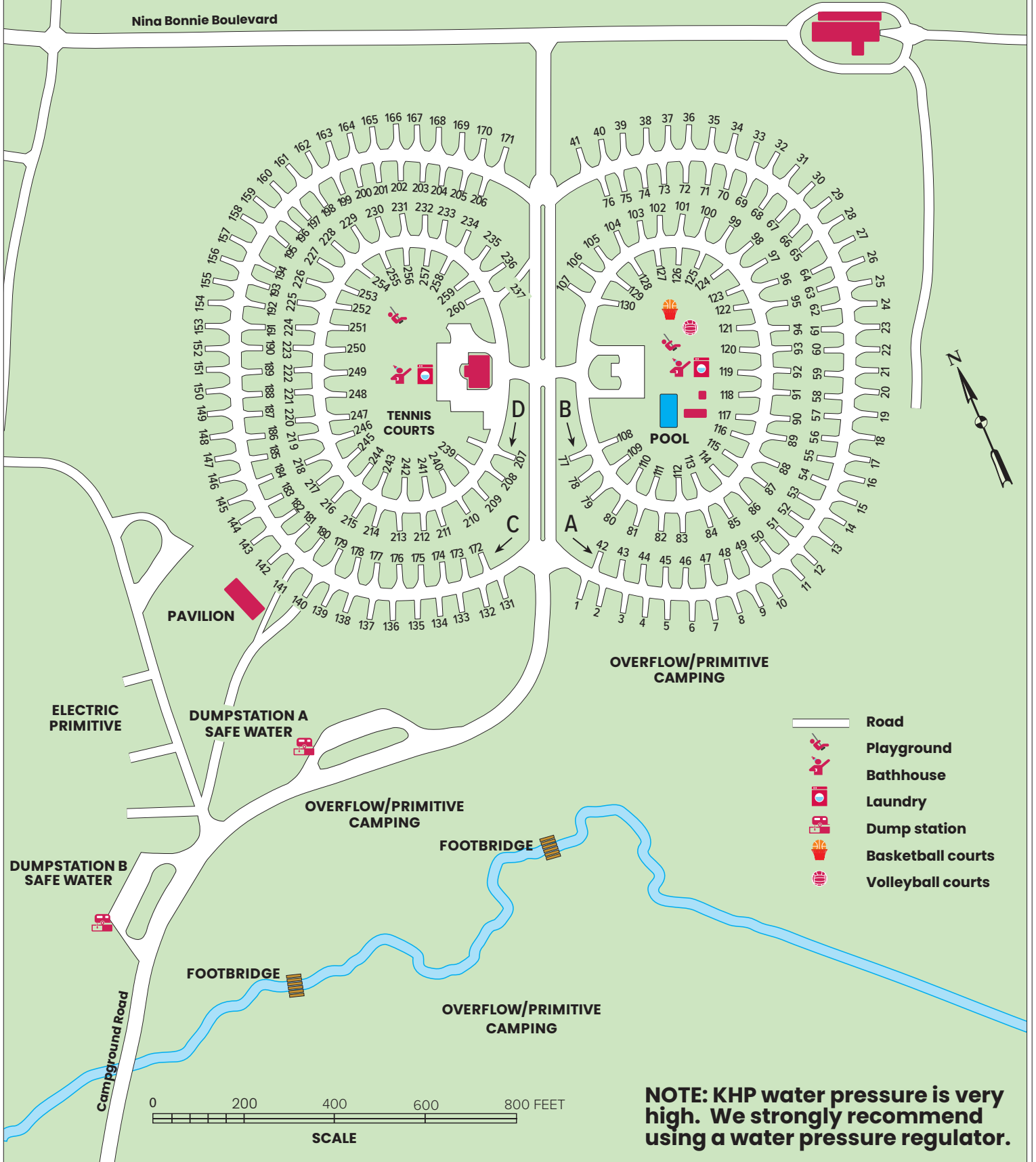

RULES & REGS

1 Check-in time is 2:00 p.m.; check-out time is 12:00 noon. The maximum stay is 14 days in a 30 day period, unless approved by management.

2 All campers must register at the campground store or other designated area prior to going to site. Site capacity may be one RV/trailer plus one tent. If no RV/trailer, then two tents are permissible. Maximum of 2 personal vehicles and 8 people per site.

3 Any loss, theft, accident, or disturbance should be reported to the Kentucky Horse Park Mounted Police at (859) 509-1450, 24-hours a day.

4 All central service building and other facilities in the campground are for campers' use only.

5 Water is shut off early November – early March, but is available at the dump stations.

6 Pets must be kept on leash or confined to your campsite at all times per Fayette County Leash law. Pet refuse must be collected at time of occurrence and disposed of properly in waste bags. Pets must have current inoculations for rabies as prescribed by state of residency.

7 No dumping of grey or black water at your

site allowed. Grey or black water for tents, campers or recreational vehicles may be disposed of at one of four convenient disposal sites (see locations on map). Violation of this rule may result in a \$500.00 fine and/or ejection from park.

8 Campfires are permitted in designated areas or fire rings, if conditions permit, and must be attended at all times.

9 Quiet hours are observed from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. No visitors are permitted after 11:00 p.m.

10 Once you've registered and paid your camping fees, there are no refunds.

11 Picnic tables are not allowed to be moved from site to site without permission from campground management.

12 Obey speed limits and stop signs due to the high volume of children in the area.

13 Golf carts are a privilege – not a right. In order to operate a golf cart on the KHP grounds, you must obtain a KHP permit per KAR 7:010. You must have a valid driver's license in order to drive a golf cart.

14 All terrain vehicles are not allowed on KHP grounds per KRS 148:290.

15 Advertising/selling of items and or

services from your campsite or vehicle is not permitted per KRS 148:021

16 Campers must keep their sites clean and dispose of refuse in the receptacles provided. Do not put trash in fire rings. All campers will be responsible for leaving the campsite in the same condition as they found it. Any damage or repairs resulting from negligence shall be the responsibility of the camper.

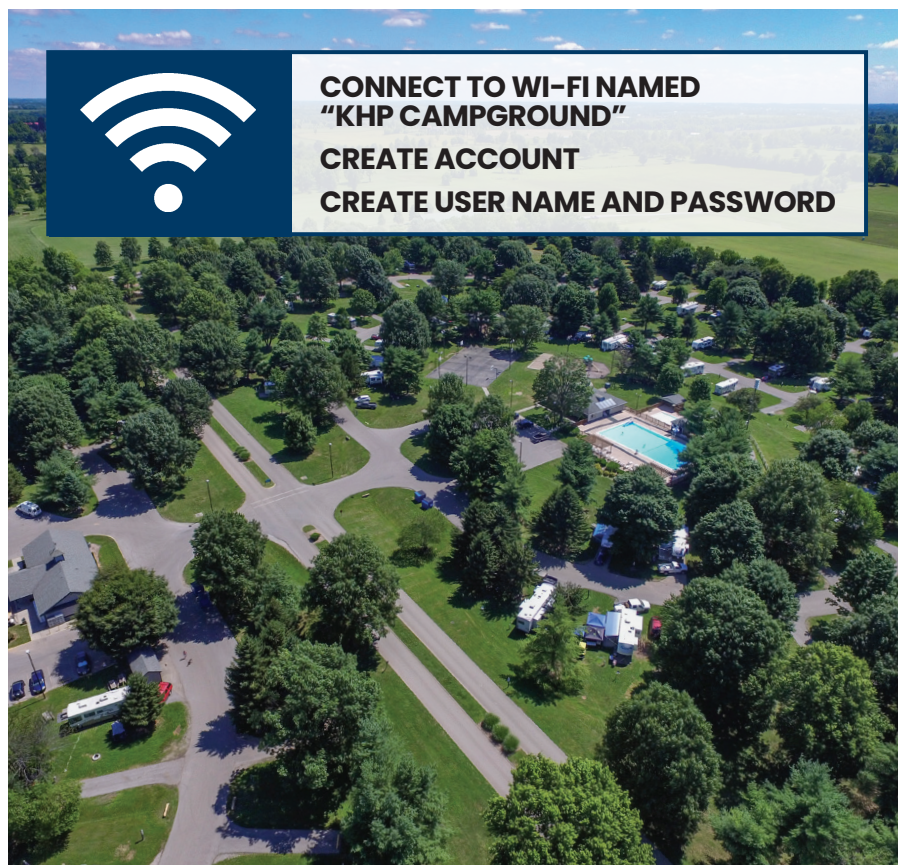
17 Firearms and fireworks are prohibited, unless permitted by management for special weekends.

18 No vehicle/RV washing permitted.

19 The Kentucky Horse Park and the Commonwealth of Kentucky shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses, or liability of every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by camper arising or resulting in any disrespect from camper's occupancy and use of premises.

20 Kentucky Horse Park management reserves the right to remove from the premises any camper or visitor in violation of the above regulations with no refund issued.

21 Site assigned for one night reservation is subject to change.

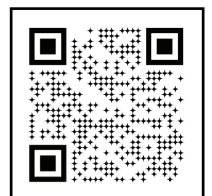

Cancellation Policy

Fee Information

If you choose to make a reservation, a non-refundable transaction fee of \$6.00 for campsites will be included in the total payable fees. Your credit card account will be charged at the time the reservation is made. Please allow up to 24 hours for your reservation to be confirmed.

Changes

Changes may be made online at www.reserveamerica.com or by calling 1-888-459-7275 at least 1 day prior to your scheduled arrival. Any reservation made with a departure date that is more than 12 months from today cannot be changed for 18 days after the reservation was made. There is no fee for changes made to a reservation, unless it is cancelled.

Cancellations

If you cancel your reservation, you will be assessed fees. The closer to your arrival date you cancel, the less money you will be refunded.

- Cancelling 15 or more prior to arrival – transaction fee \$6.00 + cancellation fee \$10.00 is applied. The use fees are refunded.
- Cancelling 14 days or less prior to arrival – transaction fee \$6.00 + cancellation fee \$10.00 + the use fee of the first night's stay is applied. The remainder is refunded.
- To cancel the day of the arrival, you must call the campground store. Refunds are subject to approval by the Campground management.
- Once a customer checks in, there are NO refunds given.
