**Animal Requirements:**

A valid Negative Coggins is required on all horses. Please do not unload your horses on the grounds until Anne Eichenberger has checked your Coggins certificate.

This is a State of Arkansas requirement for our club and there will be no exceptions to this requirement.

Proof of current rabies vaccinations should be available on all dogs brought onto the grounds. Bitches in season are allowed to compete. If your bitch comes in season after the drawing, please advise the Field Trial Secretary as soon as possible so that bracing changes can be done and posted in the club house. Please load bitches in season in the designated/flagged dog boxes at the back of the dog wagon

**DIRECTIONS**
