REMINDERS.

- Always carry proof of current RABIES vaccinations for all dogs and horses.
- (Tags are not enough.)
- Negative Coggins required for horses.
- There is water available on site for horses and dogs.
- The use of alcoholic beverages during the running of any performance event is not condoned by the ISCA and is strictly prohibited.
- ISCA endorses and supports the AKC's current policy on the misuse of service dogs.
- This club does NOT agree to arbitrate claims

Only field trial officials/judges shall be allowed to operate motor vehicles and ATVs within the course limits.

Training/Roading

No training will be allowed on the Championship grounds 30 days prior to the running of the National Championship. No roading of dogs on Championship grounds in gallery or prior to/or following day's running. You may use area across the road from clubhouse for roading.

Horse Rentals

Terry Zygalski of Gaited Pleasure Horses will once again serve as our wrangler. Full Day rentals will be \$130.00/per horse and half-day rentals will be \$70.00/per horse for advance reservations. A Horse Reservation Form with the Liability Release will be included with the premium and also posted on the ISCA website.

Animal Requirements:

A valid Negative Coggins is required on all horses. Please do not unload your horses on the grounds until Anne Eichenberger has checked your Coggins certificate.

This is a State of Arkansas requirement for our club and there will be no exceptions to this requirement. Proof of current rabies vaccinations should be available

on all dogs brought onto the grounds.

Bitches in season are allowed to compete. If your bitch comes in season after the drawing, please advise the Field Trial Secretary as soon as possible so that bracing changes can be done and posted in the club house.

Please load bitches in season in the designated/flagged dog boxes at the back of the dog wagon

Camping fee per night \$10.00

Kennel use fee per night \$1.00

DIRECTIONS

From Highway 10 in Booneville, go south on Highway 23 to County Road 217. You will only be on Highway 23 a short distance before you come to the intersection of Highway 23 and County Road 217.

You will turn left at this intersection and be traveling east on County Road 217 for approximately 7 miles. The clubhouse/office will be on your left.

If you have horses, remember they may not be unloaded from your trailer until the Coggins certificate has been checked.
