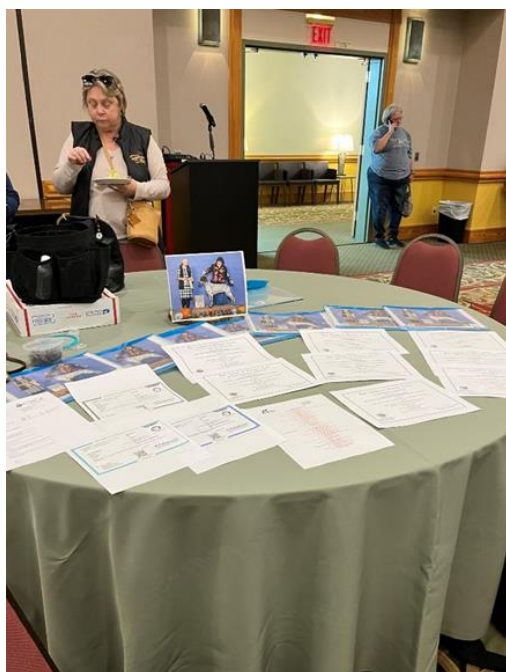


LOOKING FOR MR RIGHT

For those attending without dogs, we will provide a bag with a pad and pen so you can make notes on who you see and collect whatever handouts you may pick up as you move from table to table. We hope to have hors d'oeuvres and possibly a cash bar available to enhance the atmosphere and make this event even more relaxed and inviting.



There will be a table designated for Frozen Assets and information on dogs that are available at stud but not in attendance at the show. If you are attending with other dogs you may want to keep these on your own table, but otherwise feel free to utilize this opportunity to display what you have out there.

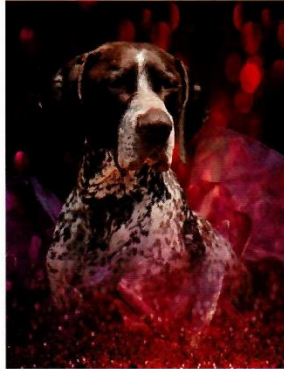

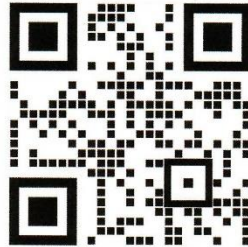
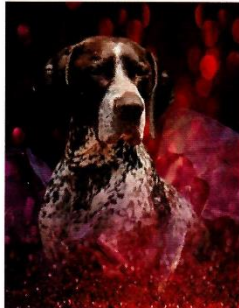
