#### **AKC SANCTIONED 4-6 MONTHS**

JUDGE: Donald Sturz

Entries will close Wednesday Noon, May 10, 2023, at Superintendent's office.

One combined class will be offered for breeds of dogs that are (4) four months & under (6) six months An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries. A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants or household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition.

AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise. Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges. Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process for this 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy in Show Competition.

#### NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the owners that are not professional handlers. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form. Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Professional handlers,\* household members and current assistants to professional handlers\* may not exhibit. Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

• If the Best of Breed winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

Field Trial Classes - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have placed in a Regular Derby, Gundog, or an All Age Stake at a licensed AKC Field Trial. Exhibitor must Attach Verification to the entry form (trial name, date, class and placement). Puppy stakes do not count. Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to compete.

Versatility/Hunter Certificate Class - Class for dogs & class for bitches that have attained his/her Versatility
Certificate, Versatility Advanced, Versatility Excellent, Junior Hunter, Senior Hunter, Master Hunter,
Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches are eligible to compete. (Photo copy of Certificate must be attached to entry).

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Best Puppy Competition - For winners of the Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch 6-9 months and 9-12 months classes unless defeated by another puppy for Winners or Best of Winners.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

Note: Non-regular classes involving multiple entries may be judged before or after Best of Breed. As the judge's decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog, no one of the dogs making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed by virtue of having won the class.

Stud Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is shown with not less than two nor more than four of Dog Class and Brood Bitch Class: Each entry is snown with not less than two nor more than four of their get. The merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not considered in the placement of the entry. It is the quality of the get that forms the basis for the judge's decision. All get must be examined and gaited. The Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must also be examined to determine if there is a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Rules, AKC policy or the breed standard. All get must be entered in a regular class in order to be eligible to compete in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class. Handlers of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch, and all get being exhibited, must wear armbands. Ch. 11, Sec. 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch Class."

**Brace Class:** Two Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in the brace class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Brace Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Brace Class."

**Team Class:** Four Dogs, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. Dogs competing in the team class must have at least one common owner. Dogs do not need to be entered in any other class. Dogs comprising a Team Class must be named at the time of entry, and full particulars must be given for each dog on individual entry forms. If a dog which is to be part of a Team is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Team Class only." An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Team must be marked accordingly in the space provided for additional classes as "Team Class."

MAILED ENTRIES FOR BRACE AND TEAM MUST CONTAIN A LIST OF ALL TEAM MEMBERS WITH THEIR REGISTRATION NUMBERS. #### POINTS FOR RESERVE WINNERS DOG & BITCH

CH. 16: SEC. 1 (new 6th paragraph) Each AKC Parent Specialty Club shall have one designated Parent Club National Specialty Show. Unless the Parent Club, in its Application to the AKC to hold its National Specialty, chooses to exclude the following Award; At the National Specialty the dog designated Reserve Winners Dog and the Bitch designated Reserve Winners will be awarded a three (3) point major, provided that the number of dogs competing in the regular classes of the Reserve Winners sex totals at least twice the number required for a five (5) point major, in the region in which this event is held. No Major for Reserve Winners shall be given based upon an award of Best of Winners. In counting the number of dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge or from which all awards are withheld, shall not be included.

#### JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT

At the conclusion of Best of Breed judging, after picking Best of Breed, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog and Select Bitch, the judge at his discretion may choose up to 10% of the Best of Breed entry for an Award of Merit. The award shall be a medal on a ribbon to be worn around the neck of each dog selected. Winners Dog and Winners Bitch are not elicible for Awards of Merit.

#### PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS

All Irish Setters who have earned a title, both American and foreign, are eligible for the Parade, for which a fee of \$21.00 will be charged. Entry form must state "PARADE OF TITLE HOLDERS". Entries must be mailed to Sandy Jones as directed on entry form. Rosettes with dog's name inscribed will be offered to all participants in the Parade. Rosettes must be claimed the day of the show. Rosettes will not be mailed. SEE ENTRY FORM ON PAGE 15.

#### PARKING

Parking Reservations will OPEN on March 1st and close on April 30th. Please do not pay for overnight mail or Fed Ex deliveries. This year, we will group reservations based on POSTMARK date (not date received) and the date an online payment was received. All the 3/1 postmarks and 3/1 online payments will be the first placed (taking into consideration the notes you provide with your reservation!!!). Place will be various levels of reserved parking on the hotel site as described below.

**Preferred Parking:** Preferred parking spaces will consist of two standard size parking spaces located side to side. Preferred parking spaces will be located either closest to the show ring on grass, or on the show side of the hotel on asphalt. They can also be near access points to the grass areas on the back and non-show sides of the hotel. Cost \$ 10.00 per day. The spaces that are on the grass are of course weather dependent. If we have lots of rain, and the risk of damage is considered to be too high by the show chairman and her committee you will then be parked in the parking lot. Please say your prayers for dry weather!!!

**Reserved parking**: Reserved parking will be a single parking space located near the hotel access doors. Cost \$5.00 per day.

#### **RV Parking:**

- 1) Exhibitors camping off site in RVs These exhibitors may drive their RV over each day and may park their RV at the show site in a 4 space reserved parking area that allows equipment setups. The RV must be removed from the parking lot each day following conclusion of ISCA activities, however, equipment set up may remain in the designated sparking space. ANY EQUIPMENT YOU LEAVE OUT WILL BE AT YOUR OWN RISK. Each RV must have a reservation. Each RV Parking space will consist of 4 parking spaces (2 wide and 2 deep). Exterior setups are allowed. Cost \$20.00 per day.
- 2) Exhibitors Staying at the Hotel. Members that are coming to the show in their RVs may also park their RVs and use them for grooming. They will need to pay for a reserved grooming space. \$20.00 per day. You will be able to leave your RV set up and not move it. ANY EQUIPMENT YOU LEAVE OUT WILL BE AT YOUR OWN RISK. Each RV Parking space will consist of 4 parking spaces (2 wide and 2 deep).
- 3) If you want to just park your RV and not use it for grooming we can accommodate that also. Please fill out a parking reservation just so we know how many to expect. I need to let the hotel know the number of RVs we are expecting.

#### Box Truck Parking:

Parking areas for handlers with large trucks will be located on the left (west) side of the hotel in the parking area adjacent to the grass leading to the show site. Box trucks will have access to grass thru bushes that we will have trimmed. You may have to share the access point with another box truck. Each space will be 36-feet wide and approximately 50 feet in length. Cost \$50.00 per day. An additional 4 box truck spaces each 27-feet wide are available. The location of the space and length of the space will be based on the length of the box truck. Cost \$40.00 per day.

#### GROOMING

There will be no reserved grooming. There will be an area for grooming under the tent. The areas will be marked for placement of your crates and tables. If space becomes limited we may ask you to stack your crates to allow more people to set up under the tent. Private inverter generators can be used, but will be required to be 25 feet from the grooming tents. NO construction generators will be permitted anywhere on the hotel property.

#### **Biathlon Challenge**

The Biathlon Challenge is a competition to honor the most versatile Irish Setter at the 2023 National Specialty.

#### COMPETITION RULES

To be eligible, a dog must enter and compete in at least two (2) events offered at the National Specialty – agility, obedience, rally and Conformation (not including sweepstakes). Any combination of the two is acceptable. More than one person throughout the competition may handle the dog.

Dogs participating in these events can earn points, even if they do not qualify. Points, however, cannot be earned by dogs that are excused for lameness or unacceptable behavior as defined by the rules of that particular event.

Points will be awarded for only one class in each of the events. If more than one class is entered, the one with the highest number of points earned will be used.

All scoring for the top award will be done from the official judge's book(s) for each event in order to verify the Irish Setter has met the participation requirement (i.e. was not excused)

The dog earning the highest number of points during the National Specialty week is winner of the Biathlon Challenge. Winner of the competition will be announced, and the award presented after BOB on Saturday.

#### CONFORMATION

Since dogs entered in conformation do not receive scores, points are awarded based on the number of dogs defeated in competition. Dogs defeated is determined by the number of dogs entered and shown in a class, not including those excused or disqualified. The maximum number of points awarded to a dog for any given class is 14.

One point is awarded for the dog itself being entered and shown. For example, in a class of 6 entries, first place would receive 6 points (one for itself and 1 point for each dog defeated), second place in class would earn 5 points, etc.

#### **BIATHLON ENTRY FORM**

The Biathlon Challenge is a competition to honor the most versatile Irish Setter at the 2023 National Specialty.

#### COMPETITION RULES

Entry Fee: FREE

To be eligible, a dog must enter and compete in at least two (2) events offered at the National Specialty – agility, obedience, rally and Conformation (not including sweepstakes). Any combination of the two is acceptable. More than one person throughout the competition may handle the dog.

Dogs participating in these events can earn points, even if they do not qualify. Points, however, cannot be earned by dogs that are excused for lameness or unacceptable behavior as defined by the rules of that particular event.

Points will be awarded for only one class in each of the events. If more than one class is entered, the one with the highest number of points earned will be used. See 2023 Specialty Webpage for scoring details.

All scoring for the top award will be done from the official judge's book(s) for each event in order to verify the Irish Setter has met the participation requirement (i.e. was not excused)

The dog earning the highest number of points during the National Specialty week is winner of the Biathlon Challenge. Winner of the competition will be announced, and the award presented after BOB on Saturday.
