### DIRECTIONS TO EMBASSY SUITES

**From North** - (Johnson City, TN) Travel south on Hwy 19/23 (also known as I-26E), merge onto I-240W. Stay in the right lane as you merge, marked as an "exit Only" for Exit 3-b (labeled Westgate and Resort Dr.) Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center. Resort driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to your right.

**From South** - (Asheville Regional Airport: Greenville/Spartanburg, SC; Columbia, SC) Travel west on I-26, follow signs for I-240 to Asheville. Merge into the left lane and take exit 3-A which will merge you onto Patton Avenue. At the second light, make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut). The road will bear right and the Resort entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot) Follow Resort Road past the golf course to the main entrance.

**From East** - (Hickory, Winston-Salem, Greensboro, Raleigh, NC) - Travel west on I-40, take exit 53-B onto I-240W towards downtown Asheville. As you cross the "French Broad River Bridge" merge into the far right lane, marked as an "Exit Only" for Exit 3-B (labeled Westgate and Resort Drive) Merge into the right lane as you pass the Westgate Shopping Center. Resort driveway is IMMEDIATELY as you round the curve to the right.

**From West** - (Knoxville, TN) - Travel east on I-40, follow signs for I-240E (towards Asheville (left exit). Merge into the left lane and take exit 3-A which will merge you onto Patton Avenue. At the second light, make a right onto Regent Park Blvd (between Denny's and Pizza Hut). The road will bear right and the Resort entrance will be immediately on the left (before entering Sam's Club parking lot). Follow Resort Road past the golf course to the main entrance.

### GROOMING

There will be no reserved grooming. There will be an area for grooming under the tent. The areas will be marked for placement of your crates and tables. If space becomes limited we may ask you to stack your crates to allow more people to set up under the tent. Private inverter generators can be used, but will be required to be 25 feet from the grooming tents. NO construction generators will be permitted anywhere on the hotel property.

You may bring your own pop up to groom under. However the popups used for grooming will have to be well back from the show ring. So you may want to bring two, one for watching the show and one for grooming under. ANY EQUIPMENT YOU LEAVE AT THE SHOWSITE YOU DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK.

### NOTICE

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise pens.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Superintendent to be advised at once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**THERE SHALL BE NO** drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

**EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**ISCA RESERVES** the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. **ALL TROPHIES AND PRIZES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

**THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD OR AN ATTENDEE'S CHILD** is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor or attendee. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors and attendees will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the show.

**ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG SHOWS** hereby waive any claim for damages against the Irish Setter Club of America, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
