**The safety** of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

**Irish Setter Club of America, Inc.** endorses and supports AKC's current policy on the misuse of service dogs.

**It is expressly** understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**The use of alcoholic beverages** during the running of any performance/companion event is not condoned by the ISCA and is strictly prohibited.

**Irish Setter Club of America, Inc.** and its agents, employees, trial secretary, etc. will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Irish Setter Club of America, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Irish Setter Club of America, Inc., Trial Secretary, or any official thereof.

**Irish Setter Club of America, Inc.** will not be responsible for the loss of/or damage to any dog entered and exhibited, whether the result of accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is under the care, custody, and control of its owner or handler at all times. Irish Setter Club of America, Inc. officers, board members, and the Trial Secretary

assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, their dogs, or property.

**All dogs** must be on leash at all times or otherwise confined when on trial/show grounds except when in the designated warmup area or competing on the course. (AKC leash restrictions March 2009, Utah leash law/code 6.16.080). Trial grounds are defined as the entire public area of the Cache County Fairgrounds.

## **RIBBONS AND AWARDS**

In all areas of competition, a rosette will be awarded to any dog completing a title. A rosette will be awarded at each individual trial to all dogs earning a Double Q (STD & JWW), Triple Q or Quad Q, for all levels. ISCA Bronze Medallions for first through fourth places for all levels.

HIGH IN TRIAL in each trial will receive a Bronze Trophy with Irish Setter Motif offered by the Irish Setter Club of America, Inc. Two High in Trials (HIT) will be awarded on the basis of number of Q's - one for Regular jump heights and one for Preferred classes. High in Trial will be calculated as follows:

1. All Irish Setters competing in all levels.
2. Only Standard and JWW classes to count.
3. The total number of Q's earned.
4. The dog with the highest total score for Q's earned.

### **Tie Breakers:**

1. Average yards per second for all Q's.
2. Dog with the highest level Q's.

**Electronic entries 65%** (195), paper entries 35% (105). ISCA reserves the right to adjust entry limits after 48 hours. Paper entries, photocopies or images of entry forms without the agreement and fully completed information do not meet AKC requirements and are invalid. In addition, entries will not be accepted without fees or signature. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or email prior to close of entries. Move-ups must be made on or before Tuesday, May 19, 2026, 6:00 PM MDT.

**Illegible or incomplete entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Entries not accompanied by the correct fees, or a postdated check do not constitute a valid entry. Incorrect entry fees of under \$10.00 will not be refunded. A returned check for insufficient funds will have \$35.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their future entries being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**Owners are responsible** for any errors on entry forms regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be returned in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Duplicate entries will not be refunded if already processed.

**A maximum of 10 entries** per envelope is allowed. Envelopes with more than 10 entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.

**ISCA is offering a waitlist** to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing April 29, 2026, noon MDT. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's waitlist. All entries, including waitlisted entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing April 29, 2026 noon MDT. Any entries withdrawn that are received by April 29, 2026, noon MDT will be replaced by a first received waitlisted entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a waitlisted entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial by April 29, 2026, noon MDT will receive a full refund.

**Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. Female dogs that come into season after entries close and up to 30 min before the start of the trial, will receive a full refund of their entry fee minus a \$3.00 processing fee upon certification from a veterinarian.

**No entry fees** will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the club, trial committee or trial secretary.

**Irish Setter Club of America, Inc.** may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against ISCA, the trial secretary, or any officials thereof.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER**

This trial is open to dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under four months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

**SCHEDULE OF CLASSES OFFERED & JUDGING INFORMATION**

**Check-In:** Tuesday beginning at 7:30a.m.

**First dog on the line** no earlier than 8:00 am. Judge briefing will take place prior to start time.

**Crates Setup** is AFTER the ring setup is completed. ISCA and Cache County Fairgrounds will not be responsible for damage or missing items.

**Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. Neither the club nor the Trial Secretary have any obligation or responsibility to provide a service through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**CLASSES AND ANTICIPATED RUNNING ORDER**

<b>Exhibitors in all classes</b> are permitted to walk the course without a dog during a walk-through period held prior to the start of their class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class.

**Warmup area**, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warmup area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

## AKC JUMP HEIGHT REGULATIONS

**Please consult** the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

## MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

## SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

When filling out the entry form, there is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

## JANUARY 1, 2020 RULE

**Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes** Within the Same Trial – Multiple Jump Heights Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day. A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or

different jump heights within the same trial day thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms. (Chapter 1, Section 21)

**AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP**

After the close of entries, a dog, which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler, may be moved to the Novice "B" class. A request must be submitted to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of EACH trial and must state the reason and justification for the move. A dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. (Chapter 1 Section 22).

**AGILITY TRIAL MOVE-UP FORM - Use this form for higher class**

Do not send this form to AKC. Send/give it to the Trial Secretary

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an Agility title, provided that the request is made in writing (email is sufficient) to the Trial Secretary no later than Wednesday, April 29, 2026 noon. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. Refer to Chapter 1, Section 20 of the Regulations for Agility Trials for additional move-up requirements.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program<sup>SM</sup> may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.
